A plain-language summary. The numbered clauses below are what legally applies.

- This website sets no advertising or analytics cookies. None.
- There is no Google Analytics, no Meta pixel and no session recording.
- That is why you see no cookie banner - there is nothing to consent to.
- The app stores a sign-in token and a local copy of your records so it works offline.

1. Why There Is No Cookie Banner

1.1 Consent banners exist because sites set cookies that track you. This website does not set any, so there is nothing to ask you to accept.

1.2 The absence of a banner is not an oversight. It is a consequence of not collecting the data a banner would be asking permission for.

2. What We Do Not Use

2.1 lskhata.com runs none of the following:

- Google Analytics, Google Tag Manager or any other analytics product.
- Meta (Facebook) pixel, or any advertising or remarketing tag.
- Session-recording or heatmap tools such as Hotjar or Clarity.
- Cross-site tracking cookies, fingerprinting, or data brokers.

2.2 We do not build advertising profiles, and we do not sell or share browsing data with anyone.

3. What The Website Does Store

3.1 A single functional cookie may be set to remember whether a navigation panel is expanded or collapsed. It holds only that preference, contains no identifier, and is not read by any third party.

3.2 Our host may process standard server request logs, including IP address, for security and to keep the site available. These are operational records, not tracking.

4. What The App Stores On Your Device

4.1 A sign-in token, so you are not asked to log in every time you open the app.

4.2 A local copy of your business records, so billing works with no connection and syncs when you are back online. This stays on your device and is removed when you sign out or uninstall.

4.3 Preferences such as language and theme.

4.4 None of this is used for advertising or shared with advertising networks.

5. Your Control

5.1 You can clear or block cookies in your browser settings. Because the only website cookie is a layout preference, blocking it costs you nothing beyond that preference being forgotten.

5.2 Signing out of the app clears the stored sign-in token and local record cache.

6. Changes

6.1 If we ever introduce analytics or any cookie beyond the functional one described above, we will publish a new version of this policy, with an effective date, before it goes live - and add consent controls where the law requires them.
